Causing the death of millions of people in Spain and Mexico, the Cocoliztli plague had symptoms of neurological disorder causing bleeding nose, abdominal and chest pain along with dark urine. The American plague or yellow fever was an epidemic that affected most countries of the United States of America causing muscle pain and fever. The great plague of London was the most endangered counted in the history of the epidemic as it had caused 75000 death in London only.

This was The first time when the term isolation or Quarantine come into existence when the solation period was increased to forty days. like covid-19, this plague affected the respiratory symptoms causing pneumonic diseases. The great plague of Marseille vanished out the 1 lakh population of France and its other provinces. Another plague that affected most of the population of the world is the American polio epidemic, Spanish flu, Asian flu, aids pandemic and epidemic, H1N1 swine flu pandemic, west African Ebola epidemic, Zika virus epidemic, Covid virus 2019.
